

## **Zimbabwe Heritage Festival Data Protection Policy**

At the Zimbabwe Heritage Festival, we are committed to protecting the privacy and security of personal information entrusted to us. This policy outlines how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard the personal data of our participants, vendors, volunteers, and website visitors in compliance with the UK Data Protection Act 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

#### 1. Data Collection and Use

We collect personal data such as names, addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, and other relevant information when individuals register for the festival, purchase tickets, or fill out forms on our website. ### 4. Data Retention

Personal data will be retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected and to comply with legal requirements. Once the retention period has expired, the data will be securely deleted or destroyed.

### 5. Individual Rights
